Objective (s)	<ul> <li>To raise the profile of reading within the community.</li> <li>School staff to function as role models for lifelong reading.</li> <li>Children to experience the need to read specific books they have encountered during LiRe activities.</li> </ul>
Age level (s)	• 6-12
Preferable number of participants	• 15 - 30
Duration	Throughout the school-year
Setting, materials,	Place: Classrooms or library
and preparation	Materials: A shelf painted in gold, selected books
Step -by-step description	<ol> <li>Teacher/ Librarian puts a new shelf in the classroom or library, but does not explain its use.</li> <li>Next day s/he paints the shelf gold.</li> <li>Next day s/he posts a sign on it, saying "The Golden Recommendations Shelf."</li> <li>When students' curiosity reaches its peak, s/he places around 10 of her/his favourite age-appropriate books on the shelf, and explains this to the students.</li> <li>The teacher/ librarian writes a personal note in each of the recommended books, explaining to the students why s/he has placed it on the shelf.</li> <li>A special sign-out log is created for these titles.</li> <li>As the shelf is bound to empty quickly, the teacher/librarian keeps adding different books; e.g. autographed books, multiple titles by favourite</li> </ol>

	author or from favourite genre, etc.
Notes to reading promotion facilitator	<ul> <li>The teacher/ librarian can keep some of his/ her favourite books from childhood on this shelf.</li> <li>For autographed books, the teacher could take a photo with the author and paste it in the book.</li> <li>Books that have personal value to the teacher/ librarian could also be placed on "The Golden Recommendation Shelf."</li> <li>The shelf could be named differently; e.g. "Mrs. B.'s Treasure Shelf," etc.</li> </ul>
Suggested follow-up actions/ activities	The teacher/ librarian could buy new hardcover books for this shelf whenever possible.
